The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. The international jury may refuse to hold a hearing when a boat protests based on these rules. This changes RRS 60.1(a) and 63.1.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 [DP] Competitors shall comply with RRS 40.1 at all times while afloat. The personal flotation device (PFD) shall at least fulfil the requirements of ISO 12402-5 or an equivalent standardization.
- 1.3 Races will not be started when the wind speed exceeds 23 knots on the starting vessel, in average over 10 minutes. The decision to start or abandon a race will be at the sole discretion of the race committee and will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 1.4 No national authority prescriptions apply.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the official notice board from June 1st 2023 on.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located on the event website.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communication on VHF channel 15 and 17.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors of the 12mR class on VHF channel 15 and to the competitors of the 5.5mR and classic Dragon class on VHF channel 17.
- 3.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

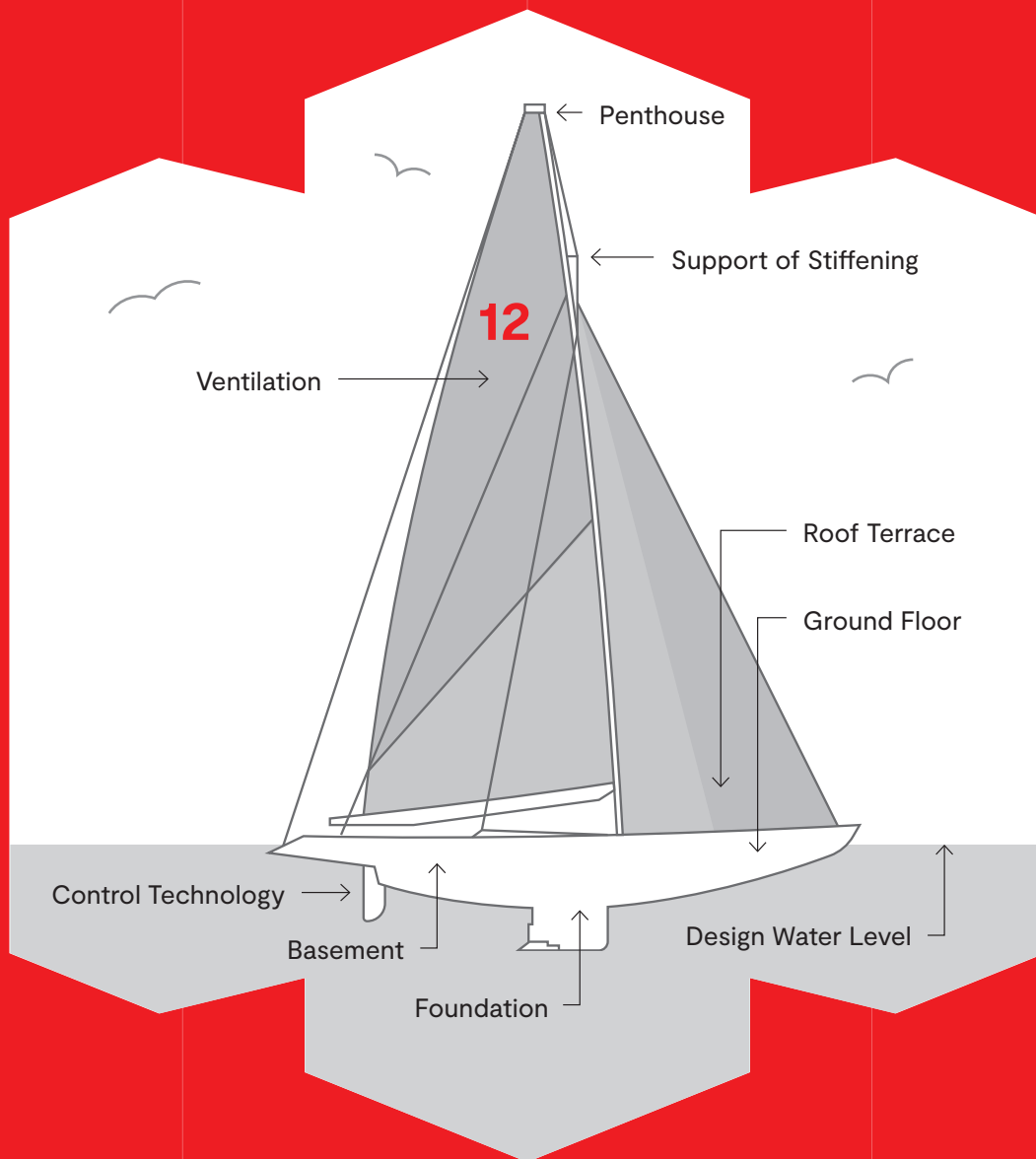
4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the following classes:
 - 12mR
 - 5.5mR
 - Classic Dragons: Boats built in carvel planked construction (all years) or if built in strip plank construction older than 25 years; therefore, the following boats are not eligible: cold moulded construction boats, boats of strip plank construction younger than 25 years and/or boats made of glass reinforced plastic.
- 4.2 To help preserve the integrity and safety of the event and its participants, and as recommended by the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) with its resolution of 28 February 2022 and the related recommendations of World Sailing and Deutscher Segler-Verband e.V. (DSV) to all organizing authorities, entries shall not be open to boats representing Russia or Belarus and/or competitors holding only Russian or Belarussian nationality. The organizing authority may amend this rule in the event of a change of circumstances or following any further World Sailing decisions on the situation with Russia and Belarus concerning the war against Ukraine in definition and with reference to UN Charta principles.
- 4.3 A final crew list signed by the skipper shall be delivered to the race office upon registration.
- 4.4 The person in charge shall provide a valid official licence prescribed or recommended for the racing area. This may be either an official licence or an equivalent DSV licence, "Sportsegelschein" or for the relevant age group a "Jugendsegelschein". Members of other national authorities shall provide an equivalent licence issued by their national authority.
- 4.5 Each competitor shall be a member of a club affiliated to his national authority of World Sailing.
- 4.6 Eligible boats may enter no later than May 8th 2023 by registering online at the event website and paying the entry fee. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees. Entry will be completed by registration on site.
- 4.7 Entries after May 8th 2023 may be accepted at the sole discretion of the organizing authority.
- 4.8 Upon request to race@fsc.de, the organizing authority may send invitations to comply with local visa procedures.

5. FEES

5.1 Entry fees are as follows:

Classic Dragon	€ 400,00 per boat	€ 700,00 per boat

5.2 The entry fee includes:

- 5.2.1. All Social events
- 5.2.2. 5.5mR and Classic Dragon only: The launching fee for one launching and one haul-out.
- 5.2.3. The berthing fee at the Glücksburg yacht harbour of Flensburger Segel-Club from June 7th to 12th 2023. In case of a longer berthing time, the boat shall pay an additional fee for this period at the harbour master's office.

5.3 The entry fee shall be paid to the bank account of Robbe & Berking Classics at HypoVereinsbank,

naming the event, the name of the helmsman and the sail number.

5.4 The entry fee shall be paid upon entering, even if the entry is cancelled later or the boat does not show up. The fee is non-refundable, except for the event or class being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected.

6. [DP] ADVERTISING

6.1 Boats may be required to display event advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. Boats shall not display advertising from previous events.

6.2 It is prohibited to distribute and display advertising material both in the area of the shore facilities and jetties or to attach such material separately on the boats and harbour facilities, unless prior permission has been given by the organizing authority.

- 7.2 12mR class only: Ten races are scheduled.
- 7.3 Classic Dragon class: two distance races(Flensburg Innerfjord) and eight windward/leeward races are scheduled
- 7.4 5.5mR class only: Eight races are scheduled.
- 7.5 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 14:30.

8. [DP] EQUIPMENT AND EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 Each boat shall provide or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate.
- 8.2 Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 8.3 Classic Dragon only: Rule 13.30 of the International Dragon class rules does not apply.
- 8.4 Boats may be inspected at any time.

9. VENUE

- 9.1 The event will be hosted at the grounds of Flensburger Segel-Club. Addendum 'Driving Map' shows the location of the event venue.
- 9.2 The race office will be located on the ground floor of the FSC clubhouse, Quellental, 24960 Glücksburg, telephone: +49 (0) 4631-3233.
- 9.3 Addendum "Racing Areas" shows the location of the race areas on Flensburg Fjord.

10. COURSES

- 10.1 12mR and 5,5mR class only: The courses will be windward/leeward. Details will be stated in the sailing instruction
- 10.2 Classic Dragon class only: The courses will be distance races and windward/leeward, described in sailing instructions

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 11.2 The intention is to appoint an international jury in accordance with RRS 91(b). The right of appeal from an international jury decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2
 - a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
 - b) When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.3 RRS 90.3(e) applies.

13. SUPPORT PERSONS AND SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 13.1 All support person vessels and designated drivers shall be registered with the organizing authority no later than June 1st 2023 by registering online at the event website. The registration will be completed by registration on site (dates and times as stated in NoR 7.1). The organizing authority or race committee may refuse registrations or accept later registrations at their sole discretion.

- 13.2 To help preserve the integrity and safety of the event and its participants, and as recommended by the Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) with its resolution of 28 February 2022 and the related recommendations of World Sailing and Deutscher Segler-Verband e.V. (DSV) to all organizing authorities, registration shall not be open to support persons holding only Russian or Belarussian nationality. The organizing authority may amend this rule in the event of a change of circumstances or following any further World Sailing decisions on the situation with Russia and Belarus concerning the war against Ukraine in definition and with reference to UN Charta principles.
- 13.3 Support persons and support person vessels shall comply with local legislation and ‘Event Support Team Regulations’ published on the official notice board.
- 13.4 Fees:
- 13.4.1 The harbour fee for all support person vessels will be set by the FSC harbour masters.
- 13.4.2 The use of the FSC slipway is free of charge. The use of the crane will be charged with € 25,00 per operation.
- 13.4.3 Support Persons could buy additional tickets for Social Events at € 50,00 per event
- 13.5. Insurance:
- 13.5.1 Each support person vessel at the event shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3,000,000 EUR (or the equivalent) per incident and valid for the event.
- 13.5.2 The organizing authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of the insurance certificates in accordance with NoR
- 13.5.1 However, the organizing authority reserves the right to verify the status or validity of insurance certificates to ensure protection for all persons involved in the event.

14. [DP] BERTHING

Unless otherwise instructed, boats shall be kept in their assigned places while berthed in the harbour and/or at the club area of FSC/DHH.

15. [DP] HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

16. [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

- 16.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 16.2 Boats shall not be cleaned below the waterline by any means between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.

17. [NP][DP] MEDIA AND MARKETING RIGHTS

- 17.1 By participation in the event, competitors as well as registered support persons (see NoR 13.1) or other persons legally bound to this Notice of Race shall comply with the ‘Event Media and Marketing Rules’ by Flensburger Segel-Club e.V., published on the official notice board and presented at registration on-site, and grant the organizing authority (namely Flensburger Segel-Club e.V., Quellental, 24960 Glücksburg) marketing and media rights in accordance with the ‘Event Media and Marketing Rules’.
- 17.2 Competitors and/or registered support persons (see NoR 13.1) may be required to be available for interviews at the event.

18. DATA PROTECTION

The organizing authority will process, and store personal data collected from entering and participating in the event. Addendum “Data Privacy Policy” gives relevant information and details. This addendum is available on the official notice board

19. RISK STATEMENT / LIMITATION OF LIABILITY COGNOVITS CLAUSE

- 19.1 The responsibility for the decision to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with the Person in Charge (as defined in RRS 46); to that extent the Person in Charge also accepts full responsibility for the crew. The Person in Charge is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of the crew as well as for the suitability and the seaworthiness of the registered boat.
- 19.2 The responsibility for the decision to provide support to a competitor or to continue with it is solely with the registered support person (see NoR 13.1); to that extent the registered support person also accepts full responsibility for the crew on the support person vessel. The person in charge for the support person vessel is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of the crew as well as for the suitability and the seaworthiness of the registered support person vessel.
- 19.3. The organizing authority (namely Flensburger Segel-Club e.V., Quellental, 24960 Glücksburg), its legal representatives and/or vicarious agents shall be liable for damages, irrespective of the legal basis, only in case of intent or gross negligence or — limited to the damage foreseeable and contract-typical at the time of the conclusion of contract — in case of violation of essential contractual obligations. Essential contractual obligations are those obligations which must be fulfilled in order to make the proper execution of the contract (in this case this Notice of Race) initially possible, the violation of which jeopardizes the attainment of the purpose of the contract, and the observance of which the competitor ordinarily relies on. The limitation of liability shall not apply to claims for compensation of damages due to injury to life, body, or health or due to other legally compulsory liability offenses.
- 19.4. The competitor as well as the registered support person (see NoR 13.1) or another person legally bound to this Notice of Race acknowledges that the event is an outdoor event, so that the implementation, course and schedule of the individual events and races can be influenced by the weather conditions. In addition, the organizing authority may be bound by the specifications and rules of national and international sports federations regarding the implementation of the events and races. The schedule stated in NoR 7 for events and races held during the event is therefore non-binding.
- 19.5. The organizing authority therefore reserves the right, in particular, in cases of force majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons, to make changes in the realization of the events and races of the event, to postpone the events and races of the event or to cancel the events and races of the event. This does not constitute any liability by the organizing authority towards the competitor and/or the registered support person (see NoR 13.1) and/or another person legally bound to this Notice of Race, if the reasons for the changes, postponement or the cancellation do not result from a wilful or grossly negligent behaviour of the organizing authority. The unlimited liability in case of the violation of essential contractual obligations or claims for compensation of damages due to injury to life, body, or health or due to other legally compulsory liability offenses in accordance with NoR 19.3 remains unaffected.
- 19.6. World Sailing’s effective Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and all other rules as defined in RRS Definition ‘Rule’ (including all other documents governing the event that are referenced in this Notice of Race) in the version that are current at the time of the event are to be complied with and are explicitly recognized.
- 19.7. German law applies with regard to the implementation of this Notice of Race.

19.8 Competitors and registered support persons (see NoR 13.1) shall present a signed and completed consent and declaration form at registration. For competitors and/or registered support persons (see NoR 13.1) under 18 years of age these forms shall be signed by the parents or guardians. The forms can be downloaded from the official notice board.

20. INSURANCE

20.1 Each boat at the event shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3,000,000 EUR (or the equivalent) per incident and valid for the event.

20.2 The organizing authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of the insurance certificates in accordance with NoR 20.1. However, the organizing authority reserves the right to verify the status or validity of insurance certificates to ensure protection for all persons involved in the event.

21. PRIZES

21.1 Prizes will be awarded to the best overall scored boats of each class. There will be one prize awarded for every five boats entered but at least three prizes regardless of the number of entries.

21.2 Additional prizes will be awarded for the different groups of boat - extract of overall scoring 12mR 2 - 3 divisions , 5.5mR divisions modern, evolution and classic and classic dragon class.

21.3 The winner 12mR class will be awarded with the "Robbe & Berking Sterling Cup".

21.4 Trophies 5.5mR and classic dragon classes:

The winner of a Perpetual trophy must return the trophy at his/her costs one month before the event 2024 to the organizing committee of that event.

21.5 [NP] The winner of a perpetual trophy shall keep it in his or her safe custody and return it to the organizing authority no later than dd June 1st 2024. The winner shall be responsible for any damage or loss. It is therefore recommended to cover this risk by adequate insurance.

21.6 Prizes not claimed at the prize giving ceremony will remain with the organizing authority.

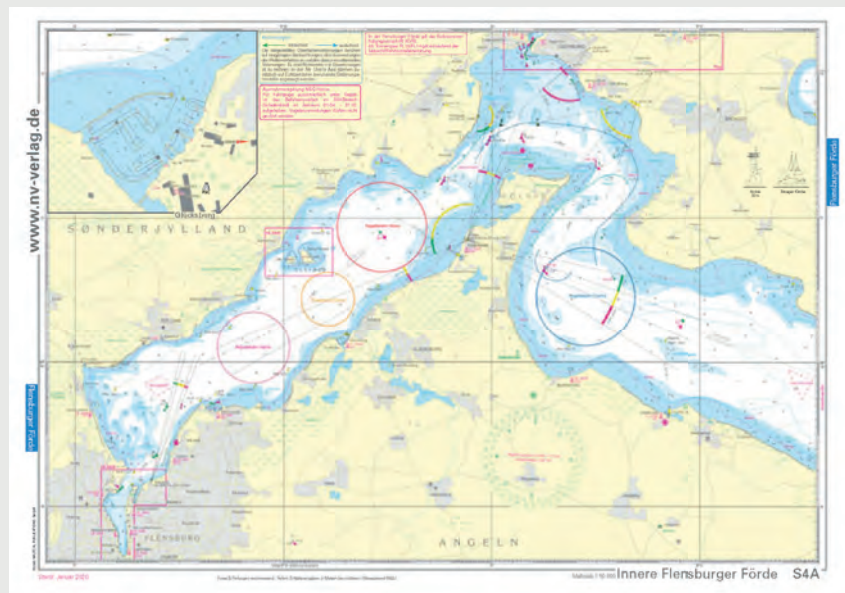
